Mission Opportunities

March Missions: Loving Hearts = Protected Hands

The ladies in Haiti cook in heavy pots over a gas cooktop or an outside charcoal fire. All they have to handle these big hot pots are clean rags. To encourage the ladies of the small church in Menard, Haiti, we would like to give hand mitt pot holders. Around 60 of the oven hand mitts are needed. If you can provide a pair of hand mitts and a colorful kitchen towel, it will be a special gift for a lady and much appreciated and loved. If you would like to add a note with your gift, translation into Haitian Creole will be written. Collection containers will be placed in the downstairs assembly room, small dining room, the hall outside the gym, and the hallway leading to the elevator on the sanctuary level.

We are still waiting on God's leading about when we are to go this year on mission to Haiti.

Community Church Events

You will have the opportunity to choose from a variety of mission projects such as building a handicap ramp, yardwork for a senior citizen, providing a meal for a local shelter, reading with children, or painting in a local elementary school.
- Details: We will meet Saturday morning at Palmer Grove Baptist Church—1606 Kingston Road at 8am for Breakfast and Devotions. Projects will begin at 9am and last until completed, (usually right after lunch). Possible Projects - Breakfast prep and clean-up 6:30 – 9:30 at Palmer Grove, Child Care for children of Community Mission Volunteers (children ages birth – 5 years) 9:00 – 12:00 noon, Children's Craft Project to take to nursing homes, Lunch prep. Prepare and deliver lunches to crews that are still working. 10:00 – 2:00 (Church location TBD), Construction Projects such as ramps, storage sheds, home and roof repair, home electrical wiring project., Clean and repair gutters, Hands-On Projects such as trash cleanup, fix-up, yard work, cut down a tree., Paint projects – needed in homes and mission areas., Prepare and take a meal to a mission group, Drive a church bus/van to deliver workers to a project, Join a singing group and share God's message in word and song at a nursing home, homeless shelter, etc., Prayer Team praying for the project on April 28.
