Mission Opportunities



• Recently I heard some very interesting statistics about the indigenous people of Guatemala. These predominantly Mayan people are noticeably shorter than most people from developed countries. One study looked at the height of several generations of these people from the rural parts of Guatemala compared to several generations of indigenous people who had immigrated to the United States. There was a noticeable difference in the height of the children and grandchildren from rural Guatemala, (shorter / normal height for rural Guatemala), compared to the children and grandchildren raised in the United States, (taller / normal height for U.S.). The study confirmed it wasn't necessarily genetics alone that determined height, but nutrition. Doctors note the importance of nutrition for a child's first 1000 days of life in regards to their development and growth. Our goal for the upcoming medical mission trip to Guatemala is to provide as many prenatal and children's vitamins as we can to the rural villages of San Andres Huista and Tojotzale. If you would like to donate any prenatal or children's vitamins, (non gummy), you can drop them off to church by Wednesday 14th. We are also collecting new and gently used children's shoes for the rural children.

Please be in prayer for our team; trip dates are Friday, February 16th—Saturday 24th.
