A Gratitude Walk (or run)

As a young boy I remember being taught and reminded often to say thank you. When given a gift, or being invited on a trip with a friend, or simply in response to a compliment, remember to say "thank you." By saying thank you, are we expressing our gratitude?

James Autry in his book, *Choosing Gratitude*, writes "Gratitude doesn't come natural, we have to learn it. We may have been taught to say 'thank you', 'appreciate it', or 'much obliged', but these may only be polite conditioned responses, not gratitude. Learning gratitude is not a social process, but a spiritual process."

When we look at our gratitude from a faith perspective, one can understand how our gratitude and spiritual life go hand in hand. All we have to be grateful for can be attributed to God. We are thankful for our faith, our family, our church family, our health; even in those times when we experience challenges in life, such as a health or family concern, we can be grateful for our God who is real and present with us during the difficult time.

Autry tells of a simple sign hanging in his office that serves as a daily reminder of gratitude that reads, "What You Have Is Enough." He shares a story of going on daily morning walks. He discovered at the end of his walks, instead of being relaxed from the exercise, he was stressed and worried. This was because he would begin his walks after reading the newspaper, and find himself worrying about all the wars, poverty, and negative news that was happening all around. After sharing with his wife about his stressful walks, she suggested for him to start praying as he walked. He began to pray during his morning walks and soon discovered he was no longer worried or stressed when he finished. Autry said this was a positive step for him in his process of learning gratitude. It was during those walks where he was able to ask himself the question, "What I am truly grateful for?" Each daily walk would be a time of prayer and praise for all the things in life for which he was grateful.

Like Autry, I have discovered the positive benefits of a prayer walk (or run). Early in my ministry, I found a way to combine some of my prayer time with my daily run. I would take time on my run to pray for those in my family and church family in need. I would pray for my ministry and God's direction. I would spend time praising God for all the wonderful blessings in my life. Out of those prayers and praises, I was learning gratitude.

As we begin a new year, may we all take time to ponder this question, each day "What am I truly grateful for?" May we allow God to lead and guide us, to bless us during the new year, and to take time to walk and pray and be grateful.

Church Financial Update

Thank you for you faithfulness and support for Zion Baptist Church. It is through the many offerings of our church family that allow the ministry and work of Zion Baptist to continue within our church family and community. Our Year-to-Date offerings to our general fund were approximately \$347,700.00. Our 2017 Church Budgeted amount was \$387,909.60, leaving us with -\$40,206.50 under budget. However, our Year-to-Date expenses were only \$338,548.69, leaving us with a surplus of \$9,579.41 over expenses.

This past fall we implemented another way to support Zion Baptist though online giving. Through easyTithe, Zion Church family and guests are able to give online, electronically, via three different options. (Giving via webpage online <u>www.zbcshelby.org</u>, smartphone app, Giving kiosk at church) Online giving guides with step by step instructions are available at church or online on our website. *In order to offer the convenience of online giving, there is a 3% fee associated with each gift plus a \$.39 transaction fee. Each donation is credited for 100% of the charitable gift contribution*. Since September, we have received over \$6,000 in contributions through easyTithe.

House and Grounds Update

The House and Ground committee is in the process of receiving and reviewing quotes for our church roof project. Thank you to all who gave towards our Ingathering offering this year to help cover the cost of a new roof.

This month you will notice several trees adjoining our church cemetery being removed. This is necessary to prevent any more damage to our cemetery from the growing roots. There will be smaller trees planted in their place as part of this project.
