Deacon Nominations

In years past Zion Baptist has nominated and elected deacons on two specific Sundays. Usually on the 1st or 2nd Sunday of August those in worship attendance would nominate five people who they believe would be the best deacons for our church. Those nominations would then be contacted and asked if they would be willing to serve as a deacon for the next three years. Once ten individuals have agreed to serve, those names are listed on a bulletin insert and then on the 3rd or 4th Sunday of August, those in worship attendance would nominate five people from the list to serve as deacons. As most families are still traveling and on vacation before school begins, not everyone has the opportunity to participate in the nomination or election process. After much discussion about our nomination process over this past year, the deacons have decided to modify this process to allow for everyone who wants to nominate and elect deacons to have this opportunity.

Nomination -- **There will be two weeks for folks to nominate deacons.** Nomination forms / bulletin inserts will be available at church and during worship from Sunday July 29th through August 5th. Nomination forms can either be placed in the offering plate during our worship service or dropped in several nomination boxes if one chooses to nominate folks during Sunday School.

Next, all folks nominated will be contacted to see if they are willing to serve as a deacon. Everyone who was nominated and has prayerfully agreed to serve as a deacon will be listed on the deacon election ballot. Those names will be presented to the church on August 12th.

Deacon elections will be on Sunday 26th during our worship service. If someone is away traveling on the 26th, they can come by the church office the week prior to elect deacons. Also, our homebound can contact a deacon or family member to have them bring a nomination and election form to include in this process.

As we approach the time for our deacon nomination and election process, please prayerfully consider who God is placing on your heart to elect. Also, if you have never served as a deacon, but after prayer may be feeling led to consider this role, feel free to contact any of our deacons or pastor for more information about being a deacon servant leader.

Heidi Update -- Zion Baptist, along with several churches and individuals from the Salisbury area have been helping Heidi Saquic with her major eye health issues. She has lost the sight in her right eye completely, and is dealing with glaucoma, high pressure, and a cataract in her left eye. Through a combined effort, we were able to raise monies to help Heidi see an eye specialist and purchase five years of eye medicine. In the picture you can see Heidi on the right just after she was given the eye medicine from a nurse missionary, Debbie. Zion has recently helped Heidi with an emergency eye surgery on June 18, called Crio Freeze, to help eliminate the high pressure in her

right eye and save her from loosing it. As Efrain has reported, 'Gracias a Dios', Heidi made it through the surgery and is recovering well. Thanks for your support and continued prayers for Heidi.

The Nominating Committee has begun to meet in preparation and planning for our upcoming church year.

The committee requests that Zion folks to begin praying about ways they could serve through the various committees. If you feel led to serve or a particular committee or have any questions about certain committees, contact the committee or Matt.

Rotating Committees—(Members serve for a three year term)

Finance- Works with staff and other committees to form a financial budget for the church each year. Monitors church giving and expenses in relations to our church budget.

Personnel- Serves as the liaison between the pastor, congregation, staff, and Deacons. Recommends staff: salaries, job descriptions/duties, hiring, policies, and the creation of new positions.

Missions- Coordinates church-wide mission projects, such as Operation In As Much, and helps to promote various mission offerings throughout the year.

House and Grounds- Maintains the physical properties of Zion Church building and grounds by dealing with repairs, renovations, and other hands-on duties.

Hospitality– Helps to provide food, cooking preparation, and event setup for various Church fellowship activities and ministries such as Zion Fest and Memorial Day.

Scholarship– Provides scholastic opportunities for church members by implementing the gifts of Mills and Earcie Cornwell and Lee Cornwell. The committee members consist of those who are currently or have previously been educators. **Nominating**– Secures positions on Zion's standing and rotating committees, Sunday School teachers, and officers by encouraging church members to exercise their gifts and talents.

Children's Advisory Committee- Works in partnership with the Children's minister to plan and promote activities and ministries that are fun and appealing to children while seeking to help them grow in Christ. The committee seeks to offer support for children and nurture them through opportunities of fellowship, worship, and education.

Music-Supports the music program, gives input regarding music selections, seeks creative ways to promote choir opportunities, assists in planning and hosting choir socials, works with the music director in an effort to have a successful music program.

Transportation- Helps to maintain and ensure through service, inspections, and repairs the church bus and van are in good and safe working order.

Youth Ministry Council— Works in partnership with the Youth minister to plan and promote missions, activities, and ministries to build the unity of the group and help them grow in their faith.

Standing Committees

Lord's Supper--Works with church staff to schedule, prepare, and clean up quarterly communion.

Softball--Organizes and runs Zion's church softball league. Works to signup teams, set rules, run concessions, and prepare the field.

Flower--Keeps a calendar of Sunday morning worship flowers dedicated to others and makes sure there are flowers in place each Sunday. Also takes care of the Chrismon tree, poinsettias, Easter Lilies, and gives a New Testament to newborns.

Baptism--Assists baptismal candidates on the day of baptism and makes sure there are enough gowns and towels for each candidate.

History--Records the history of Zion and publishes it each 25 years. Also helps with other projects as needed. **Sound System, Media, and Video**- Operates the Sound, Computer, and Video systems each Sunday during worship. Also helps setup and run sound and video systems used for other church ministries.

Homebound— Ministers to the homebound members of our church through calls, cards, and the opportunity to watch Zion's Sunday worship service.

Cemetery- Meets with the deceased person's family to provide information regarding cemetery plots. Also deals with related matters regarding Zion's cemetery grounds.
