Community Fellowship, Worship, and Missions

What a blessing it was to join together with our community partner churches, Dover, Eskridge Grove, Palmer Grove, and Zion folks to fellowship together, worship together, and serve on mission as brothers and sisters in Christ. On April 21st, over 200 hundred people came to our Community Fellowship Dinner. It was an evening of great food, fellowship, and entertainment. Over \$4,500 was raised to help Eskridge Grove's building fund as they are moving church locations. Thank you to all who donated cakes, pies, and other silent auction items. Thank you to all who shared their musical gifts to provide our entertainment for the evening. A special thank you to Iris Spangler and her cooking team as they provided the delicious meal. My favorite part of the evening listening to all the wonderful music praising our God. We ended the music with everyone in attendance standing and singing together our praise to God, it was definitely a spirit filled time of worship.

The following Saturday we joined together again for the purpose of reaching out to our community. Over 100 folks participated in a variety of projects such as praying for all the mission projects, providing breakfast and lunch for the mission teams, making crafts and visiting with folks at Peak nursing home, providing meals for the women's and men's shelters, singing at different nursing homes and Hospice, cleaning out gutters for the elderly, building handicap ramps, and pruning rose bushes, spreading mulch, and trimming trees at the men's shelter. One project I was excited to see completed was the men's shelter transitional home. This will be a place where men who have completed their training and Bible study programs at the shelter will be able to live as they make their way back into the community to work. This home which is directly across the street from the shelter, was donated for their ministry. It needed much work on the outside, and will need a total renovation on the inside. In just seven hours, folks joined together to remove and haul off several loads of trash, cut down trees and bushes, tear down part of the outdoor building whose roof had collapsed, install lattice on the back porch, and remove old fencing and poison ivy. The result was a major transformation. This project is a reminder of what God can do in our lives and the lives of those men who will be soon moving into this home. God can remove old trash, overgrown vines, and fill us with a new spirit and direction. God can equip and empower us to change for the better. God can transform lives. May we all be reminded of God's power of transformation and commit to praying for the men who will be moving into this transformational home.

House and Grounds Update

The new church roof was completed during the third week of April. The total cost was \$39,450.00, and all of this cost was covered by our 2017 Ingathering offering, our insurance check, and a special gift to the church roof project. With the remaining funds left after the roof was paid, we were able to purchase two heat pumps for the third floor and pay for their installation. Enough funds remained to allow us to have most of the money needed to buy an ice maker for the Family Life Center to replace the broken one. Thank you to everyone who gave toward these much needed projects.

Our upcoming House & Grounds projects will be cleaning out our church gutters, sealing the gutters, and cleaning out several of the drains. If you are interested in helping, contact anyone on the House & Grounds Committee.

Financial Update

With several icy and cold Sundays this past winter, we had lower attendance and as a result, a lower offering. This put us behind on our yearly budget gifts. Each Sunday our budget goal is about \$7,500, and our average weekly gifts have been \$5,500-\$6,500. Currently, we are about \$17,000 behind budget and \$14,500 behind in meeting our expenses. As always, staff and church leaders are working to keep expenses low and working to be good stewards of our church resources. As a reminder, during our upcoming summer months when many in our church family will be away, you can mail in your weekly offerings or give online at zbcshelby.org to support our church ministry budget needs. Thank you for your continued financial commitment to support Zion Baptist Church.
