A few years ago, our Zion family participated in a church-wide survey. We looked at our programs, our ministries, and our missions. We asked questions to consider what we were doing well and what possibly we could do better. We identified several areas in which we felt were doing well, but at the same time asking ourselves, "Can we do better?" One of those areas that Zion is doing well is our Small Group ministries. Small groups are opportunities when we come together in smaller church circles for discipleship, missions, ministries, and fellowship. Our Sunday School classes, choir, youth and children ministries, mission groups, JOY club, softball and basketball teams are some examples of Zion's Small Group ministries. They are a vital part of our church family as they help minister within our congregation and our community. Many of y'all have shared how much you appreciate your Sunday School class and how important it is to you. Not only is it an opportunity for discipleship and Bible study, but in many classes lasting relationships are built and friendships are made.

We are looking to add another small group ministry for the upcoming spring months, and hopefully the fall, called Life Groups. The goal of these groups will be in-reach and outreach. The opportunity to build and strengthen relationships within our church, (in-reach), and being intentional to invite others to join the group, (outreach). In addition to fellowship and building relationships, another purpose of these groups will be to learn and grow in our faith. Study topics will depend on each group. Some groups may choose to study a specific book of the Bible, a book study, a life topic, or discuss the weekly scripture and sermon. One Life Group offered this spring will be the Financial Peace class, helping individuals and couples learn more about managing their monies and resources.

What? Life Groups

When? Life Groups will meet from 4—8 weeks, depending on each group. Some groups may meet weekly on a Sunday evening, while other groups may meet every two weeks on a Tuesday evening. Groups for this Spring may begin as early as the week of March 8th.

Where? Life Groups will meet either at church or in the community, typically in someone's home. Who? Life Groups are open to anyone who wants to participate, or who has an interest in the specific topic of study. Groups are also encouraged to invite guests.

How do I get involved? In order for us to offer several Life Group studies, we need Hosts, Facilitators, and Participants. A Host would be someone who opens up their home, or church space, for the group to meet. A Facilitator would be someone who leads the study and discussion. Participants are folks who attend, learn, discuss, and hopefully strengthen their faith. Groups can have sign-ups for different folks to bring pickups each week and some alternate to provide childcare.

### Kentucky Mission Trip, March 19th-22nd

We will be traveling to Kentucky to work at the Cleft Rock Retreat Center. This trip is open to folks of all ages and skill levels. Cleft Rock Retreat center relies on volunteer church groups to help with the maintenance, repairs, and cleaning needs. We will be repairing and sealing a wood cabin, installing a dishwasher with the necessary plumbing and electrical work, repairing a handicap ramp, cleaning the inside of cabins and meeting facilities, and any outdoor work such as cutting up wood, clearing off hiking trails, and raking up leaves. We are hoping to have one group from the church travel on Thursday morning and return Saturday evening, and also have another group travel on Friday afternoon and work Saturday and return Sunday afternoon. # **Zion 5K Run for Missions and Connect Cleveland County**

Though not a fan of making New Year's resolutions, Jen Kramer decided to add meaning to 2018 by declaring it #theyearoflove. Each day she wrote a "love note" to a different person, expressing gratitude and offering encouragement. Recipients ranged from waiters and custodians to relatives and a terminally ill friend.

The experiment may have stemmed from the sudden, unexpected death of Kramer's father while she was away at college. "Why don't we say those things to people while they're here?" she tells the *Chicago Tribune*. "It's easy to be kind, and it's easy to tell people how you feel."

Kramer's campaign didn't cost a cent, yet it changed her life and touched hundreds of people in the process. Wherever she went, she discovered that "love showed up." It's simple, Kramer says: "You just have to look."


