Thank Offerings

"Sacrifice thank offerings to God, fulfill your vows to the Most High, and call upon me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you will honor me." (Psalm 50:14-15 NIV)

In Psalm 50, the writer describes an image of God as King entering the temple of Zion as the place where court will be held. God expresses his concern for the people not keeping the covenant and being disobedient to God's will. God doesn't reject their sacrifices and offerings as worship, but states He does not need them. God simply requests a 'sacrifice of thank offerings' and for the people to call upon Him, to rely on God in their day of trouble and he will save them. God does not need our worship or thank offerings, but wants us to freely give our worship and thanks to Him. All throughout Scripture, we see the importance of giving thanks. Paul in 1 Thessalonians 5:18 says, "give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." In Psalm 103, the writer calls us to Praise the Lord, to give thanks to God for forgiving all our sins, healing our diseases, redeeming our lives, satisfying our desires with good things, and working for righteousness and justice when we are oppressed. We give thanks to God for removing our sins as far as the east is from the west. We are thankful that our God is slow to anger. We give thanks to God for His stead-fast and unfailing love.

One way we can give to God our thanks offerings is through our prayers. This past Wednesday evening during our Bible study and prayer meeting we offered up the Lord's prayer with verses from the Psalms that resonate each section of the prayer. I invite you to take time in your own personal Bible study to search and pray some of the verses of the Psalms that speak to you in a way to voice to God your own thank offerings.

The Lord's Prayer and Psalms

"Our Father- 'as a father has compassion for his children, so the Lord has compassion for those who fear him." (Psalm103:13) who art in heaven—'before the mountains were brought forth, or ever you had formed the earth and the world, from everlasting to everlasting you are God' (90:2) Hallowed by your name -'O come, let us worship and bow down, let us kneel before the Lord, or Maker!' (95:6) Your Kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven- 'The Lord works vindication and justice for all who are oppressed' (103:6) Give us this day our daily bread- 'so teach us to count our days that we may gain a wise heart' (90:12) Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us—'the Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love' (103:8) And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil—'save us, O Lord our God, and gather us from among the nations' (106:47) For Thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory, forever—'Blessed be the Lord, the God of Israel, from everlasting to everlasting. And let all the people say, 'Amen.' Praise the Lord!' (106:48)



Zion Mission Opportunities

Appalachian Christmas Outreach—On Sunday November 3, we will be offering up a special prayer of blessing for all the backpacks collected for the children in need. During the month of October we have been collecting backpacks filled with food, toys, and clothing items in partnership with the NC Baptists on Mission. The church is providing each backpack a Children's Bible and 'The Christmas Story' printed booklet. All backpacks will be collected and shared with children living in the Appalachian coalfields and mountains of North Carolina, Virginia, West Virginia, Kentucky, and Pennsylvania. Thank you to everyone who participated in this mission project.

Senior Center Food Collection - The Cleveland County Council on Ageing and the Senior Center provide meals to 140 seniors living in our community. There will be several days around the Christmas holiday, where they are unable to provide meals to the seniors. We will be collecting two specific items, Canned beef stew (pop top cans) and peanut butter (any size), in order to help feed those senior citizens in need during the holidays. If you are willing to donate these specific items you can drop them off at church in the small dining room, adult assembly area, sanctuary or church office, the deadline of these items to be collected is Tuesday November 26.
