March Mission Madness

If you are not a college basketball fan or if you team decided to sit this season out, March can still be an exciting time of year. This month, as part of March Mission Madness, we will have numerous opportunities to share God's love and help others in need.

Sunday March 1st, from 4:30-5:30 the youth are sponsoring a shower for the Wendover Hospice House. Folks can drop of donations in the Small Dining Room, leave them in our yellow mission boxes, or bring them by the church office if you cannot make on Sunday.

Thursday March 19th—Sunday 22nd Mission trip to Kentucky. We will have one group leave Thursday morning and return Saturday evening, another group will be leaving later after work on Friday and return on Sunday. Work projects will be for all different skill levels ranging from cleaning cabins, clearing off hiking trials, installing a dishwasher, and sealing a cabin.

Saturday March 28th—Zion 5K Run for Missions. This will be our 4th time hosting this event with the goal to raise monies for mission. This year we have invited all the local elementary school students to participate, where any child 5th grade and below can run/walk at no cost and will receive a free race t-shirt.

Saturday April 4th— Community Mission Day. (Technically not a March date, but you can help plan and volunteer in March for this event.) Join us for our planning meetings on 3/3 and 3/31 and look for signups beginning on March 15th.

Ways to Serve—Upcoming Mission Opportunities

Shower for Wendover Hospice House Sunday, March 1st, 4:30-5:30 Small Dining Room. These items will be for the family members visiting patients at the Hospice House. Suggested items to donate—Individually wrapped beverages: canned sodas, fruit drinks, water. Individually wrapped snack items: cakes, cookies, chips, soup, cereal, fruit cups, pudding cups, candy bars, peanut butter, oatmeal, grits, applesauce, etc.. Paper items and utensils: paper towels, napkins, tissues, forks, spoons, knives, plates, bowls. Coffee supplies: creamer, sweetener, stir sticks.



We will be traveling to Kentucky to work at the Cleft Rock Retreat Center. This trip is open to folks of all ages and skill levels. Cleft Rock Retreat center relies on volunteer church groups to help with the maintenance, repairs, and cleaning needs. We will be repairing and sealing a wood cabin, installing a dishwasher with the necessary plumbing and electrical work, repairing a handicap ramp, cleaning the inside of cabins and meeting facilities, and any outdoor work such as cutting up wood, clearing off hiking trails, and raking up leaves. We have about ten folks signed up to serve, with Jane Cooper cooking the meals for our mission team. We have one group that will travel from the church travel on Thursday morning and return Saturday evening, and also have another group travel on Friday afternoon and work Saturday and return Sunday afternoon. There is no cost for this trip. If you are interested in serving, or have any questions contact Matt or anyone of the Missions Committee.



Zion 5K Run for Missions and Connect Cleveland County

We are hosting our 5K Run for missions again this year on March 28th. This year we are inviting several kids running clubs from the local elementary schools and allowing them to run/walk/hop/skip for free. This will be an opportunity, not only to raise monies for missions, but to have numerous folks from the community visit our church.

How can I help? We will need lots of volunteers to help with all the race preparations and also to help on race day. We need folks to donate water, bananas, oranges, and baked goodies. We will also need help getting local businesses to sponsor the race and provide door prize giveaways. There are letters available around the church and also online to give to potential sponsors. I have found many restaurants are willing to donate a gift card if asked knowing it will be for a good cause. Door prizes can be collects up until race day. We will need Business Race Sponsors Logos by March 15 for the t-shirts.

For folks who want to help on race day, we will need 4 volunteers to help with sign-ups, 6:30-7:45. We will need at least 10 volunteers directing the runners on the course, 7:45-9:00am. We will need four volunteers to helping with the finish line, 7:45-9:00. 4-6 volunteers are need to provide childcare for the volunteers and racers children, 7:30-9:00. We need 1 or 2 volunteers to help with the food and water for racers and volunteers. Usually are biggest need is for runners and walkers to participate in this race. Sign-up forms are available around the church and also online. Contact Matt or Carson to sign up to help.

Monies raised will go toward our Haiti mission partnership and a new mission project from Zion called Connect Cleveland County. The goal of Connect Cleveland County is for Zion folks to engage in a variety of mission projects to help those in need in Cleveland County. Sunday School classes, youth group, several individuals or families will decide on a mission project of their interest and passion. They will submit a request for any funds they need to complete the project to the mission committee. Then they will go and serve.
