T. MILLS AND EARCIE DELLINGER CORNWELL SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1. Applicants for this scholarship must be an <u>active member</u> (by letter or by baptism) of Zion Baptist Church for a minimum of three years prior to the application deadline. Other applicants who have been a member for less than three years are eligible for a grant of up to \$500 upon application. ("Active" is defined as participation in a majority of Worship, Sunday School, Youth Meetings, and Youth Mission activities during the student's high school years.)
 - a. The Scholarship Committee and Youth Director will verify participation in youth activities.
 - b. Applicants who have completed at least one year of college are not required to have activities verified.
- 2. Applications for this scholarship will be available in the Zion Baptist Church office by February 1st. Scholarships will not be considered for students applying in excess of four years or enrolling or continuing in a program of study above a bachelor's degree.
- 3. Any interested applicant must complete the application and return it to the church office on or before May 6th. No applications will be considered if received after May 6th.
- 4. The amount of the scholarships will be limited to 90% of current earnings of the scholarship funds. The amount of this scholarship will not exceed \$5,000 per year per applicant. The funds from this scholarship must be applied to tuition, room and board, books or college fees. Students must complete an application on a yearly basis if attending a university or community college, not to exceed four years or completion of an undergraduate degree.
- 5. The selection committee will be composed of six members of Zion Baptist Church, four of whom must be active educators or must have been career educators.
- 6. The awarding of these scholarships will be announced at Zion Baptist Church by the first Sunday in June.
- 7. The scholarships will be paid directly to the college to which the recipient will attend.
- 8. The Scholarship Committee will decide interpretation or questions about any guidelines.
