Several years ago Johnny Cash's daughter Roseanne came to perform at the Wayne Henderson music festival. She sung several songs from *The List*, her album based on a list her father gave her, 100 Essential County songs she should know. She played songs such as "500 Miles", "Sea of Heartbreak", "I'm Moving On", and "Long Black Veil." What a gift she received from her dad, a list of songs that every country music singer should know

A missionary colleague of mine recently shared an article written by Dr. David Hull regarding the list of 100 essential songs. Hull writes, "From the experience of the father comes a list that has now been interpreted by the child and has been

shared with the larger community. I saw possibilities for THE LIST the church in what I was reading. For more than sixty years my Dad preached and taught the Scriptures in churches, seminaries and colleges. His work as a biblical scholar, pastoral preacher and administrative leader gave him a unique perspective to offer a list of 100 Essential Scripture Passages. Knowing that he was faced with a terminal illness, I asked him for a list of the essential passages from the perspective of his long ministry." Hull's father shared the following list:

May we also consider writing a list of essential scriptures, those passages that have impacted our spiritual lives and in turn pass the list on to our children, family, and friends.

We have an opportunity to help with this ministry again -- The Appalachian Coalfields Ministry! It is sponsored by the NC Baptists on Mission and seeks to meet the physical and spiritual needs of people living in the Appalachian area. Churches are asked to respond to a Christmastime need by helping with the Appalachian Christmas Outreach 2020.

If you would like to help, this is what is needed:

- 1. Decide if you would like to help a boy or a girl.
- 2. Decide on the age: 4-7, 8-10, 11-14 or 15-17
- 3. Buy a backpack.
- 4. Purchase and fill the backpack with:
- A. New items of warm clothing, for example: gloves, socks, winter hat, scarf, etc.
- B. Include small <u>pop-top</u> canned food, for example: ravioli, tuna, beef stew, vegetables, and fruit (3 or 4 cans).
- C. One or two new, age-appropriate non-breakable toys, for example: small cars, balls, dolls, yo-yo's, jump rope, sidewalk chalk, card games, Legos, etc. For the oldest children (15-17) instead of a toy, buy things like flashlights, small thermos, hunting/fishing magazines for boys. For girls, buy things like jewelry, hair accessories, books, skin care products, etc.
- D. Hygiene items toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, soap, washcloth, brush/comb. (Put items that may leak in a one gallon zip-lock bag.)
 - E. Wrapped hard candy
- F. Put a note on the outside of the bag stating if it's for a boy or girl and the age.

Zion's collection date is by October 28th at the church office.

Once they are collected, a children's Bible and a scripture Christmas story will be added to each backpack. The NC state goal is 18,000 backpacks. Zion had a great outpouring of love last year, and the need is even greater this year.
