Zion Missions for May

Meals of Hope is a food packing ministry organized by Operation Inasmuch that will prepare 100,000 dry packs of oatmeal, macaroni and cheese, rice and beans, and spaghetti . All the food will stay in Cleveland County. It will be distributed to church food pantries, church backpack programs, and other organized food distribution sites .

Volunteers are needed to help pack food bags for the 2nd and 3rd shifts, 12:30-2:30, & 3:00-5:00. There are still about 50 open spots for each shift. As of April 29th, the 2021 giving is \$27,418.00 above expenses and is \$1,994.00 below the budget. The weekly 2021 budget is \$7,055.04

Parable of the Pencil


