Giving God Space

"God said to Moses, "Climb higher up the mountain and wait there for me; I'll give you tablets of stone, the teachings and commandments that I've written to instruct them." (Exodus 24:12 MSG)

Moses is an important person for the Hebrew people. He spoke to the Pharaoh on their behalf, he led them out of Egypt, was there when the bread fell from the sky, and now is climbing Mount Sinai to get some instructions God has for the Hebrews. You could say Moses is a key person for the Hebrews and their relationship with God. Moses is their leader and spokesmen for God. We can only imagine what this story would be without the important character of Moses. You could even say there would not be a story of the Hebrew people without Moses' leadership and guidance.

As important as Moses was to the Hebrews, he is portrayed to us in this story as only necessary and not indispensable. If Moses hadn't picked up the mantle of leadership, God would have prepared another person. What is key in this story is not what Moses did, but what God did. When Moses returned from the mountain, he did not talk about his exciting getaway for 40 days; he was silent about himself so he could talk to the people about God.

How many of us are silent about ourselves and only concerned about God? Too often we get in the way of God's work in our lives. It is easy to be consumed with the worries and anxieties of life. With a new year beginning, we can become stressed about the uncertain future. One simple command of Jesus we often fail to obey, "do not worry about tomorrow." (Matthew 6:34 NIV) As we make our lists for the New Year filled with promises and hopes, may we remember God is the center of our story and may we step aside and give God room in our life to work.
